### *Technology*

#### About this course:

This course has a technical focus and is perfect for students who aspire to fulfil a range of creative tasks within the music industry. Students will increase their skills and knowledge across a range of musical practices involving live sound and studio based audio. This includes recording, producing, mixing and editing. It can be used as a pathway into a specialist Certificate III in Music Industry (Sound Production or Performance).

#### Public Performances:

A minimum of 15 performances – consisting of 5 location recordings and 10 live mixes (including lighting & stage management) – 75 hours

#### Home Practice:

A minimum of 3 hours per week – 75 hours over the duration of the course.

#### Work Placement:

30 hours required for assessment – to be negotiated with each participant. It is likely that many students will participate in our very own student-operated record label and radio show!

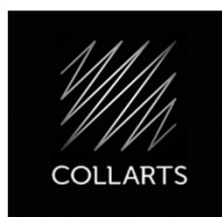
